Similar mandate to the US Office of Personnel Management, Office of Management and Budget, Government Accountability Office, and others...





What is GCFM?




GCFM is the Government of Canada's finance and material management solution based on standardized business processes

GCFM is using the latest product offerings from SAP (e.g. S/4HANA) and will provide a standard GC configuration

GCFM is a critical part of the GC's Financial Management Transformation (FMT) initiative which aims (in part) to reduce the ongoing operational costs of financial management systems in the GC




GCFM: Highly complex... aggressive timelines...






Planning and Forecasting






Budget, Planning, Consolidation



- BPC used for budget planning and in-year forecasting
- Plans in BPC drive budgets in S/4
- Forecasts in BPC drive commitments in S/4
- Actual feed back into BPC to update forecasts



Does not meet security requirements


