Challenge: Rising Prison Population



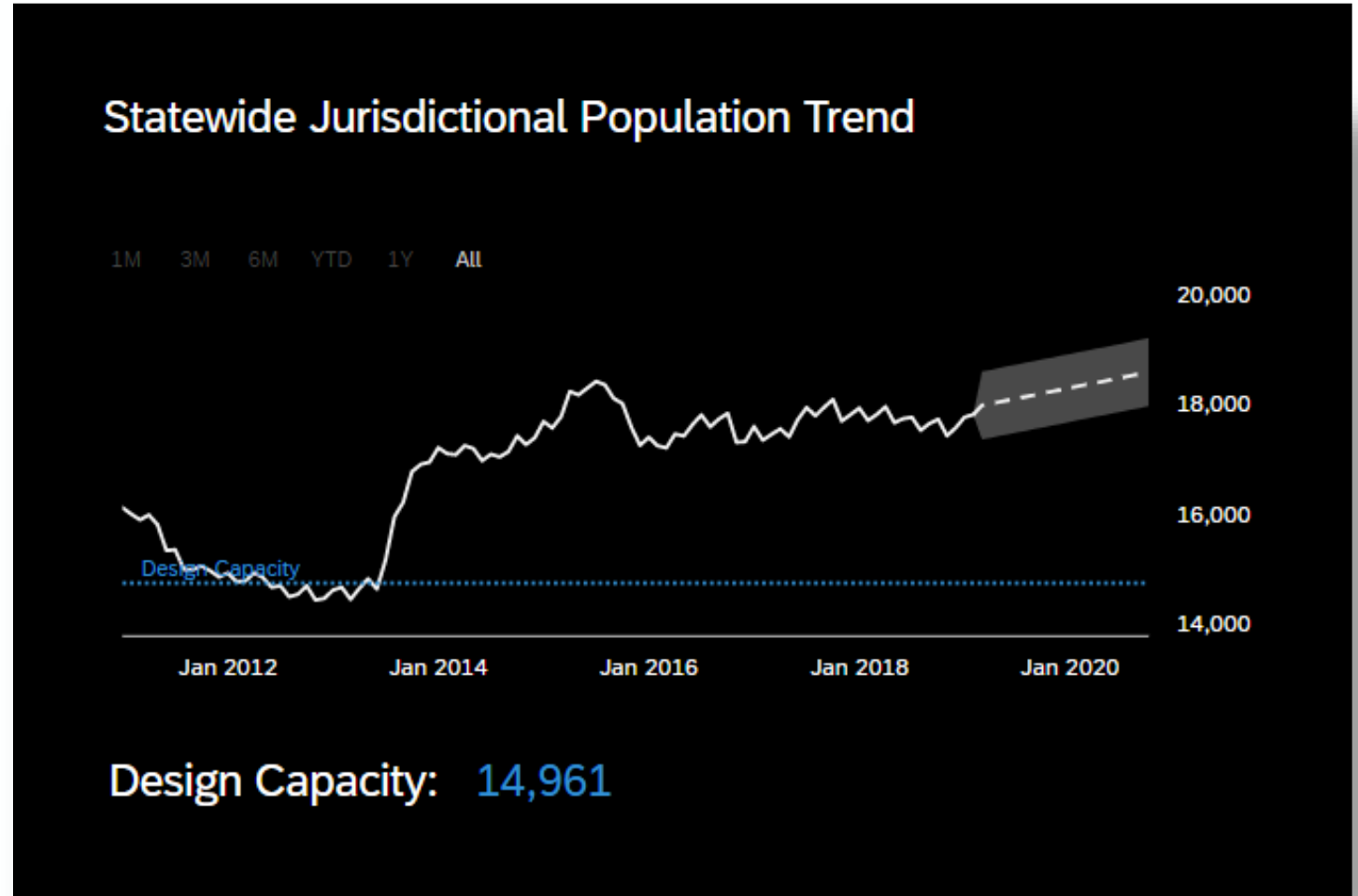
\$650M

Key Stat: Arkansas' prison population grew 26% in the past decade vs a decline of 4.5% nationally

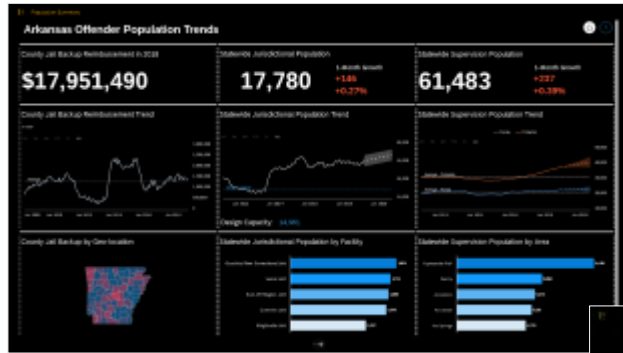

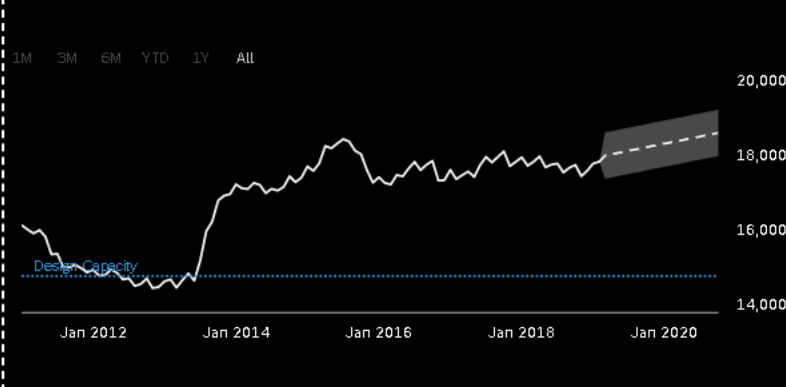

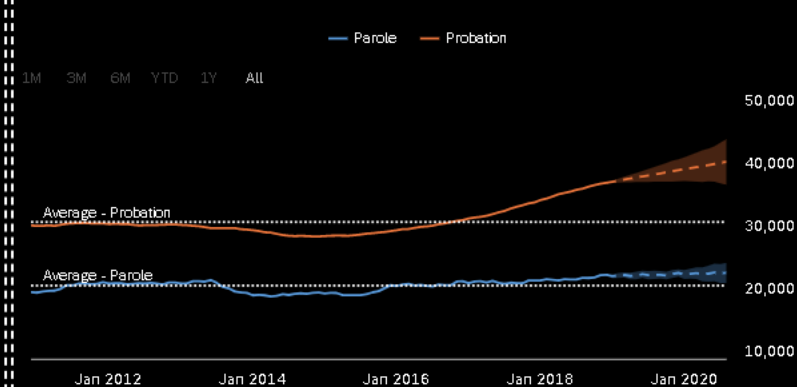
County Jail Backup Reimbursement Trend



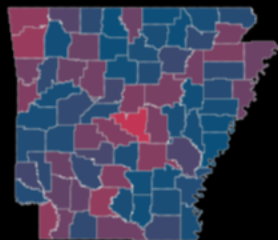
Statewide Jurisdictional Population Trend



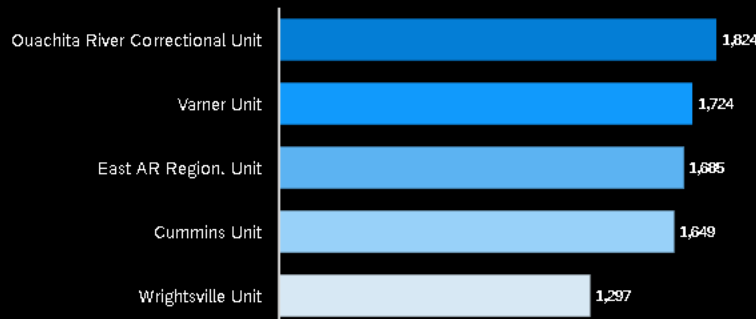

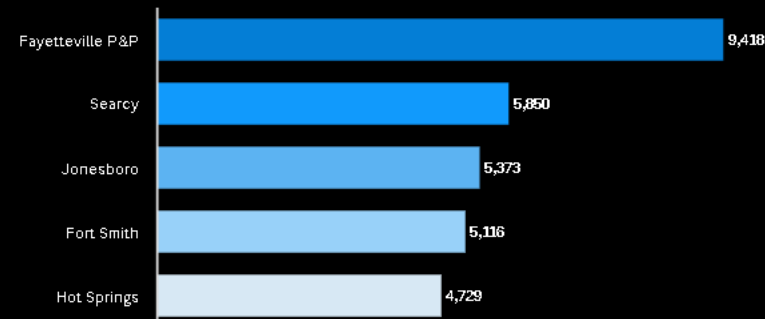
County Jail Backup by Geo-location

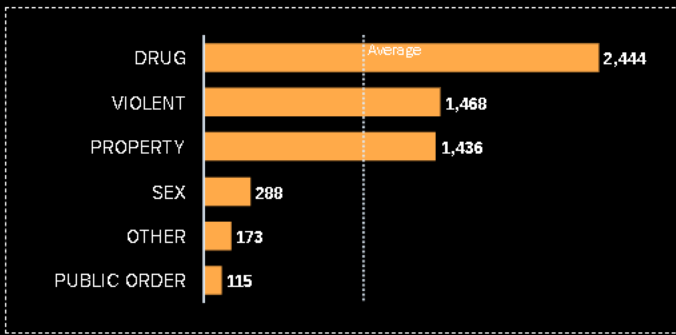

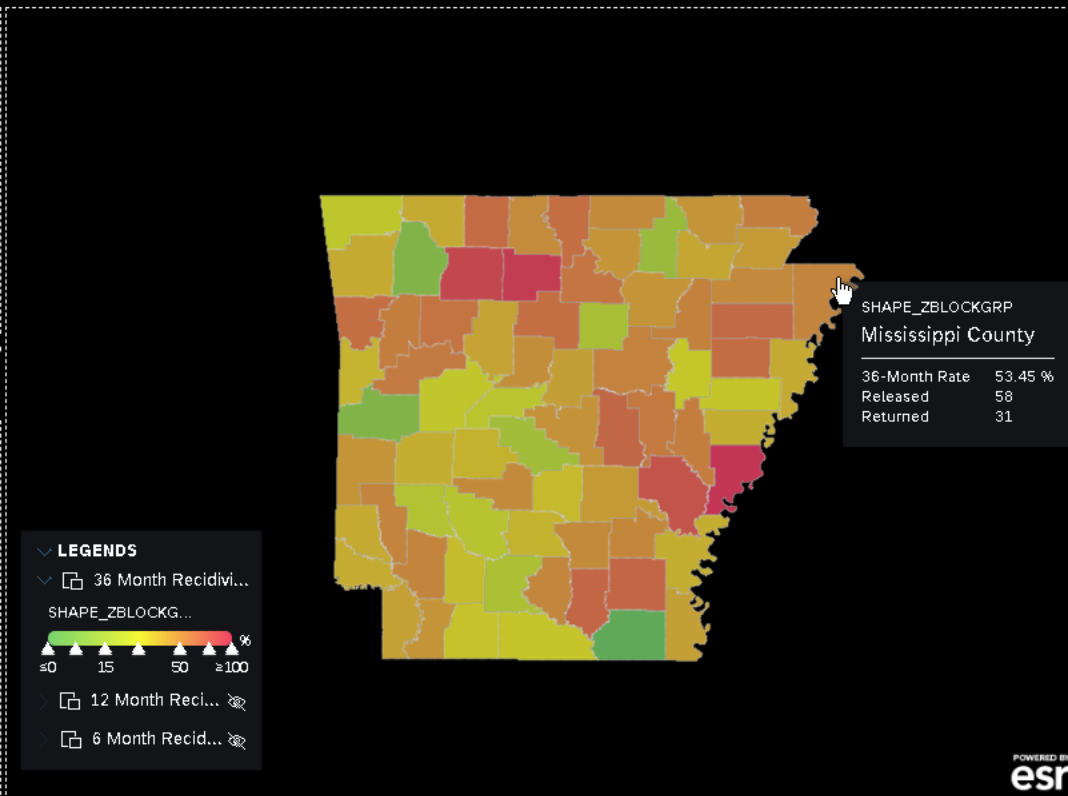

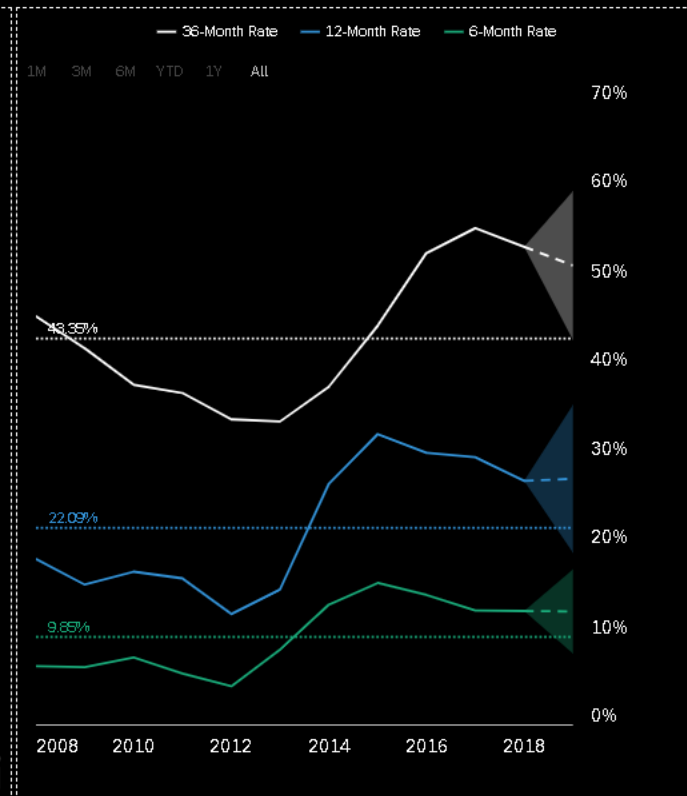

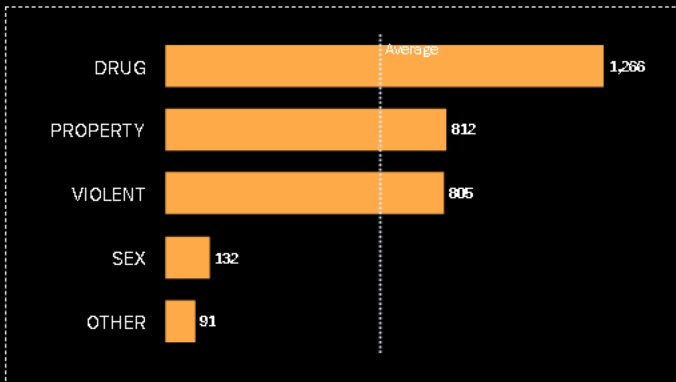

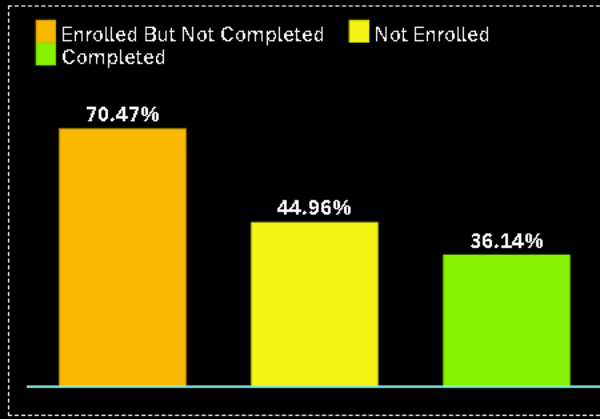
Returns By Offense Type



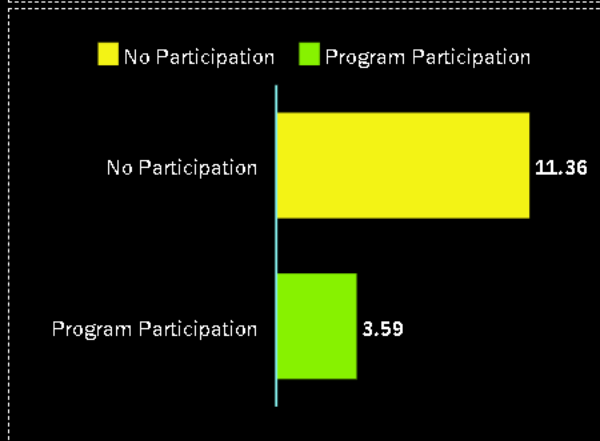
Community Supervision - Proximity to Resources



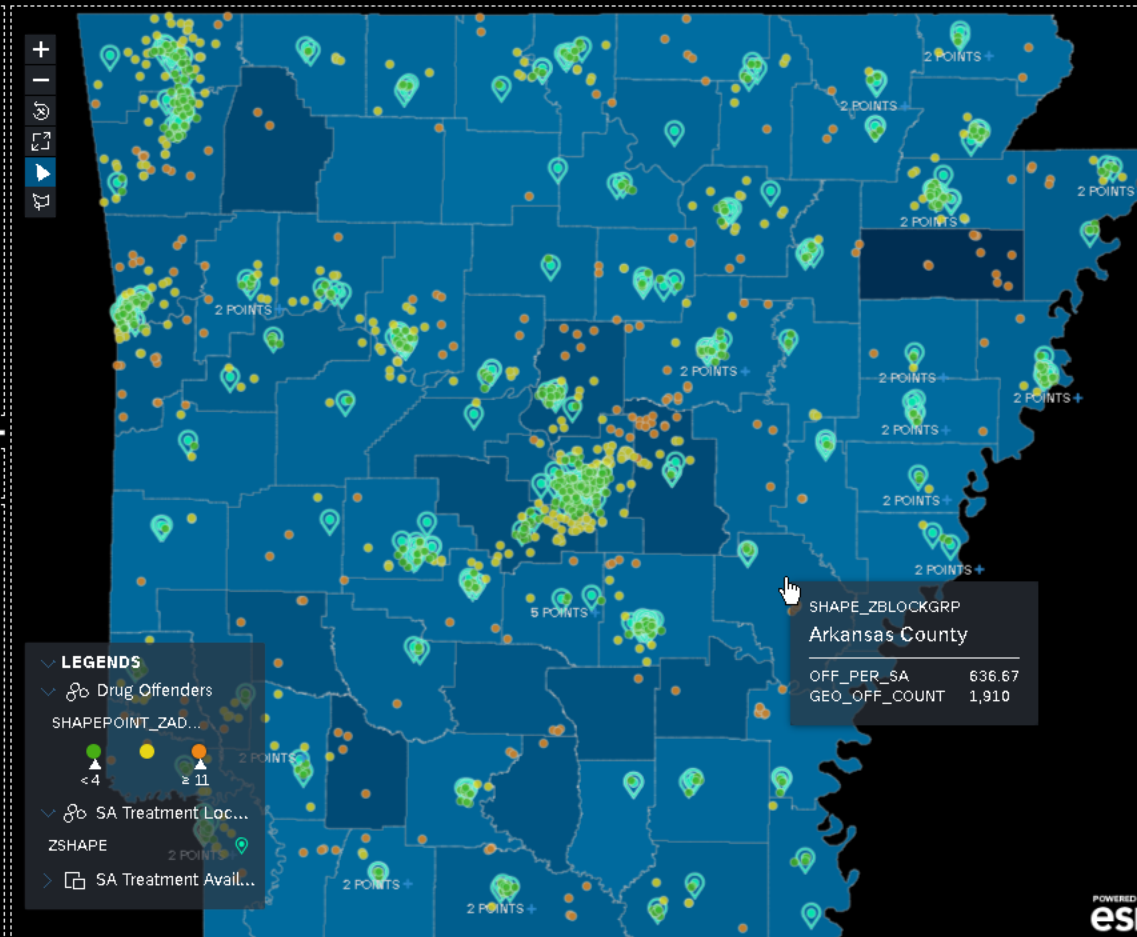
Recidivism by Program Participation



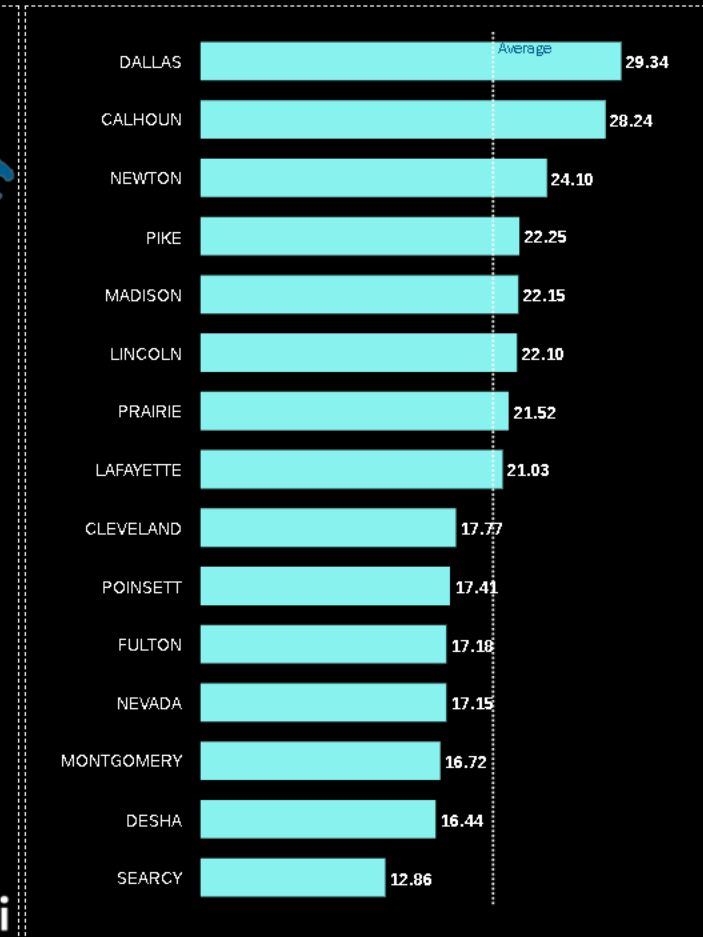
Program Participation by Average Distance

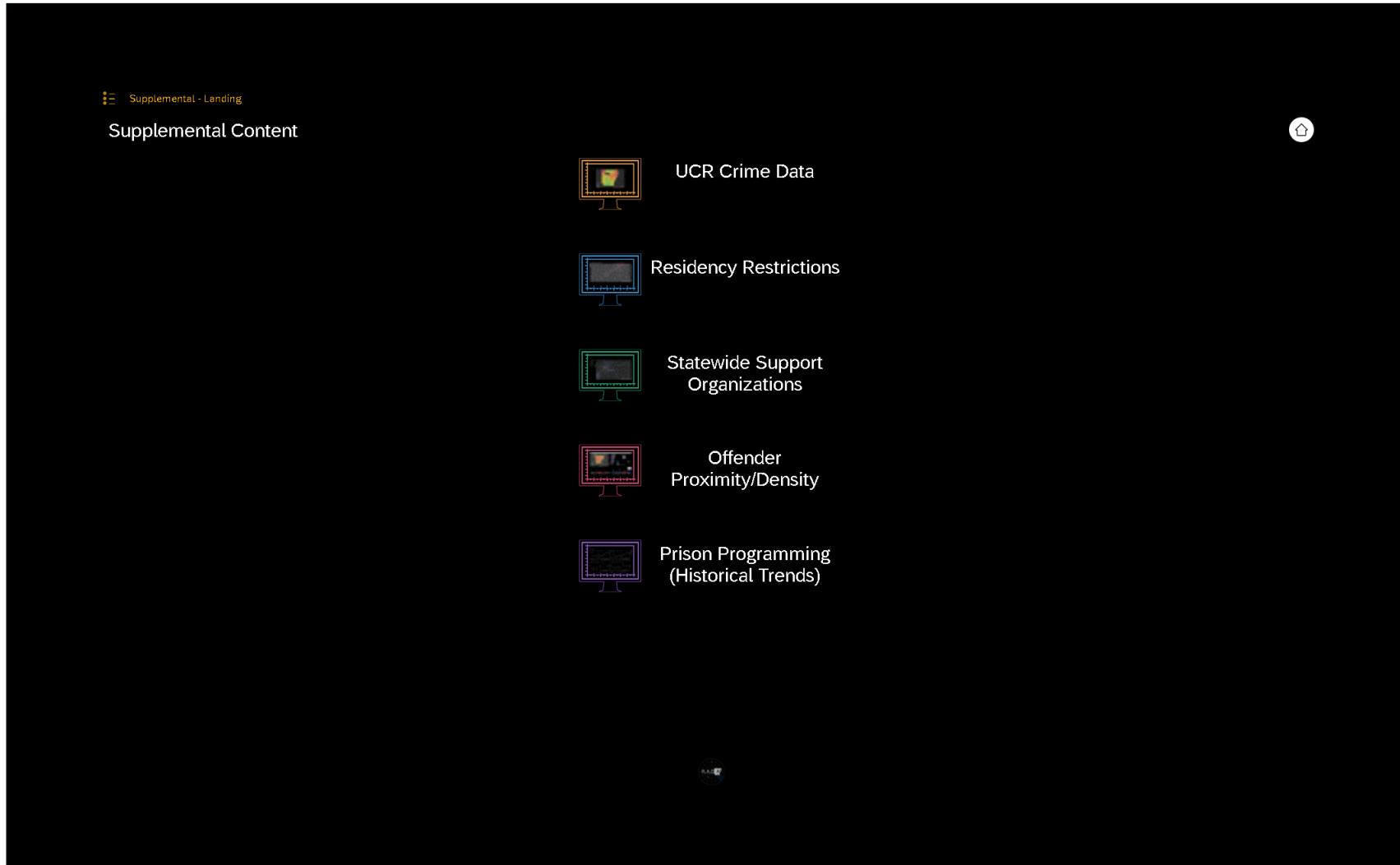

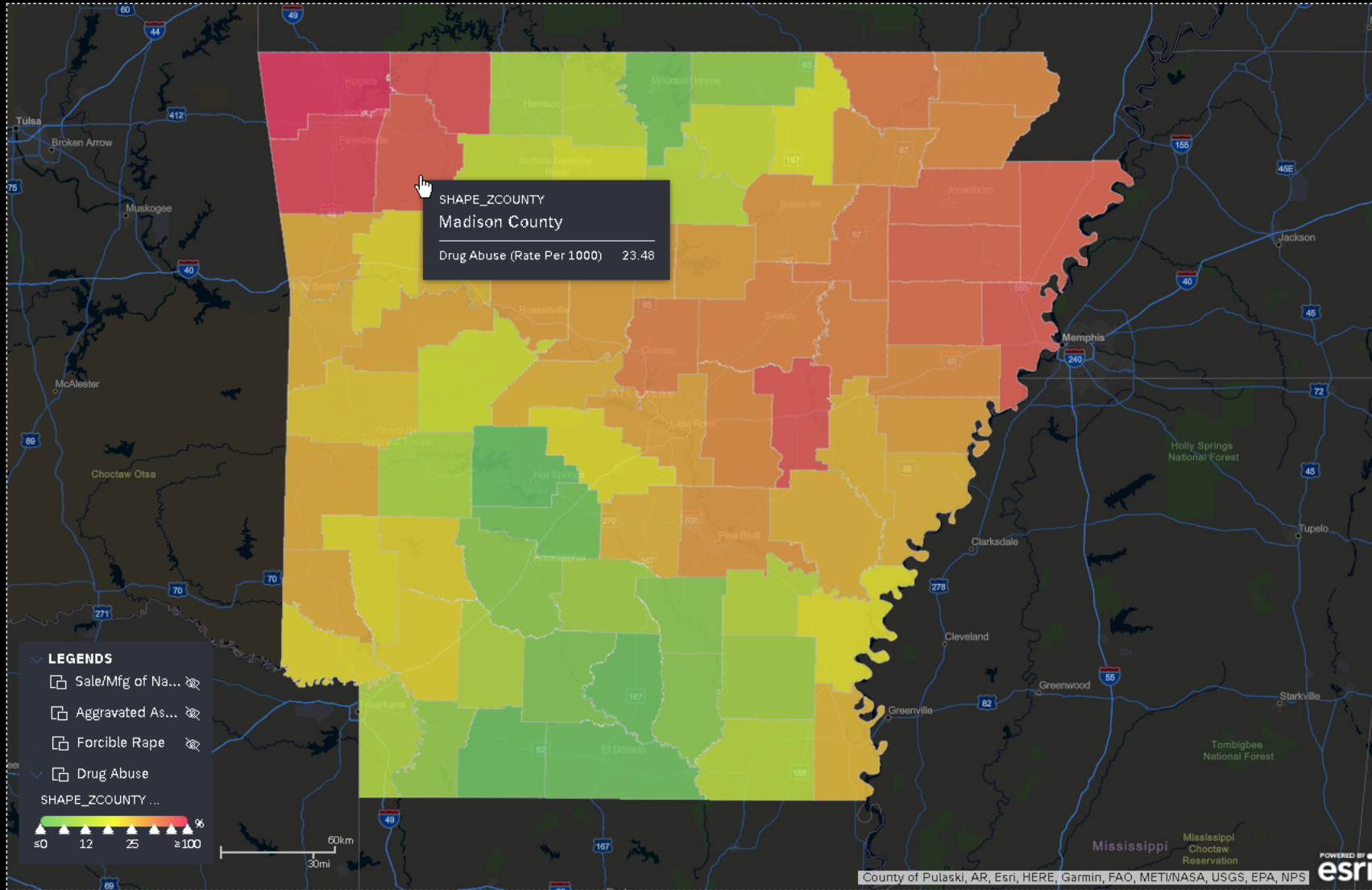

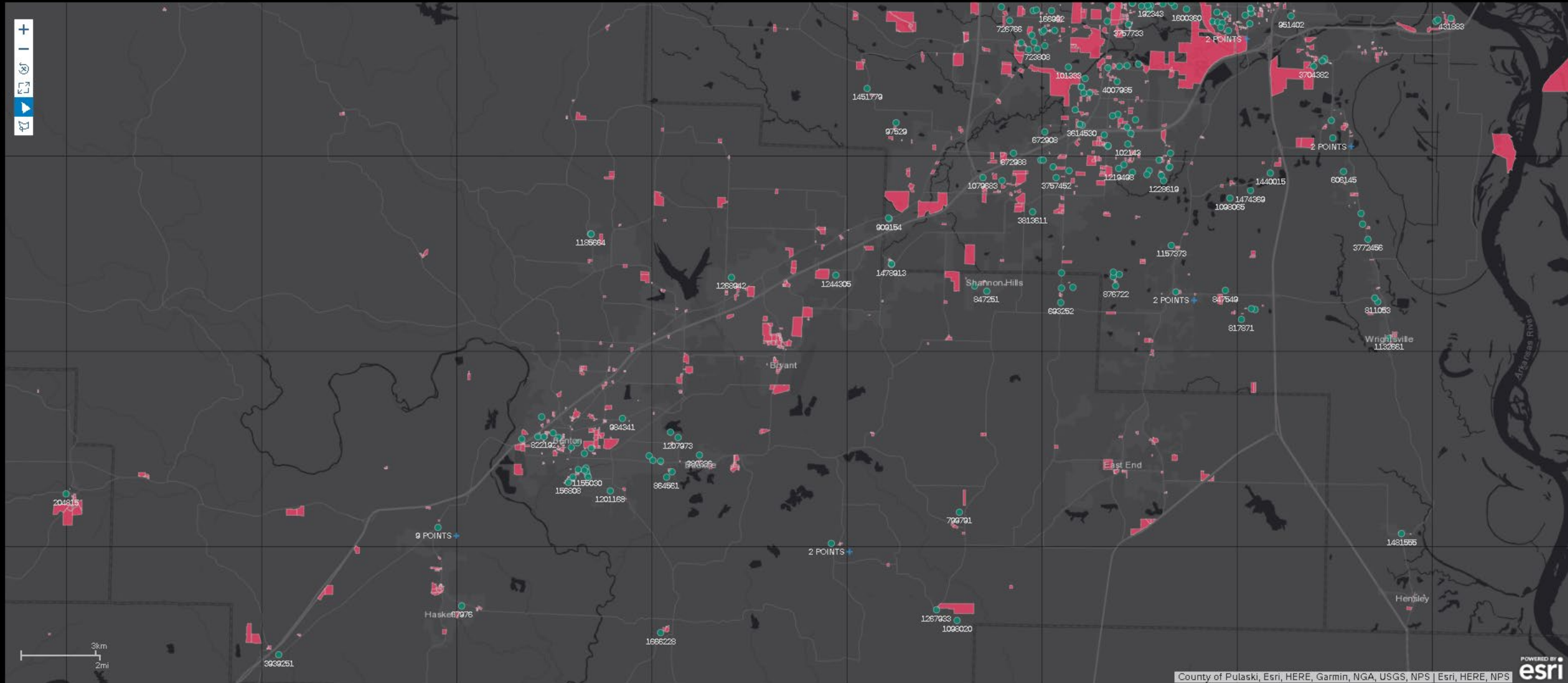
Time-to-Value (Deliverables+)

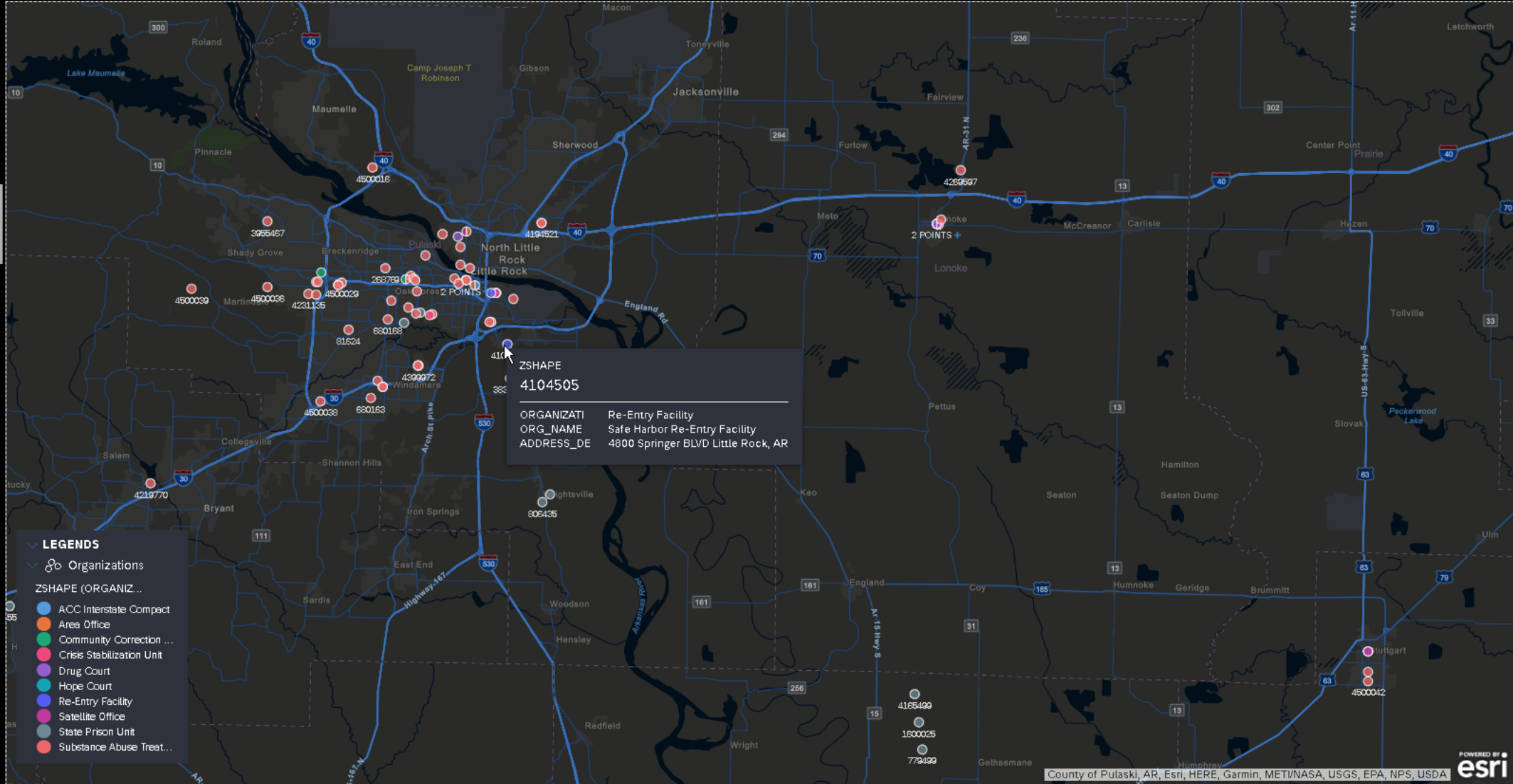


Residency Restrictions for Sex Offenders



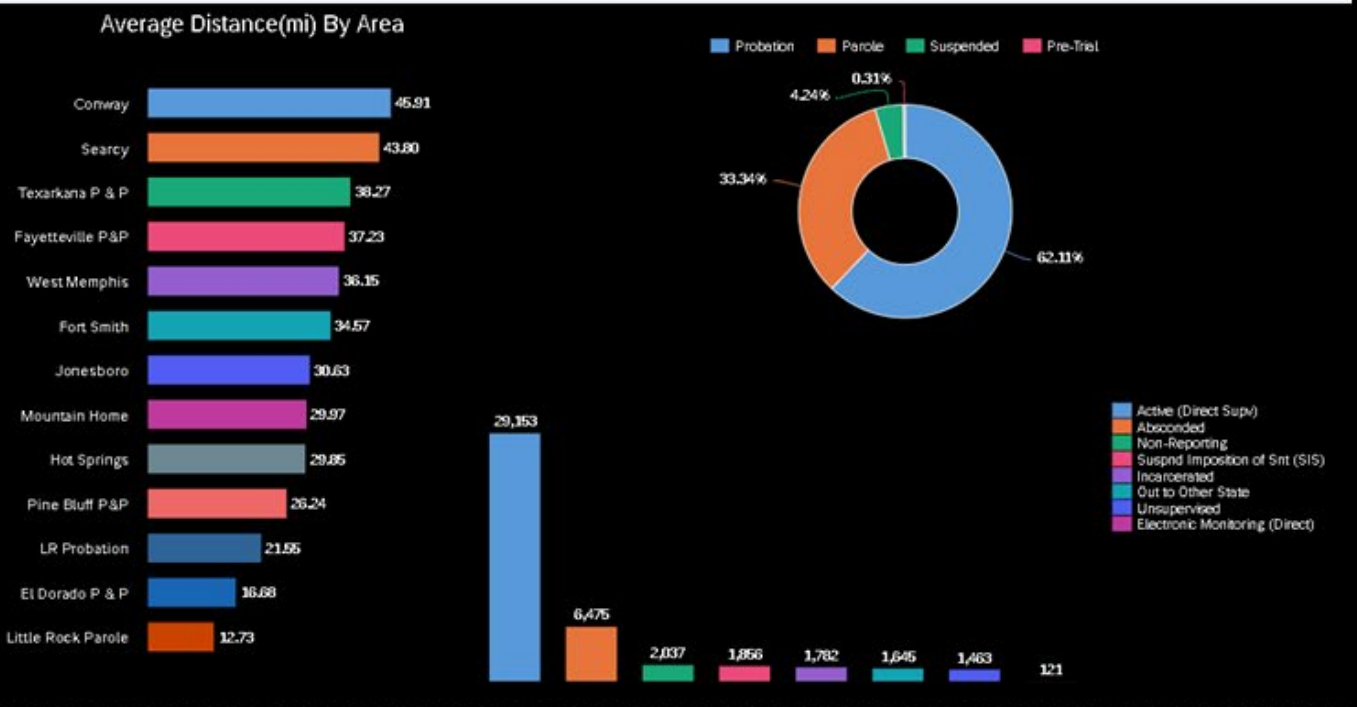
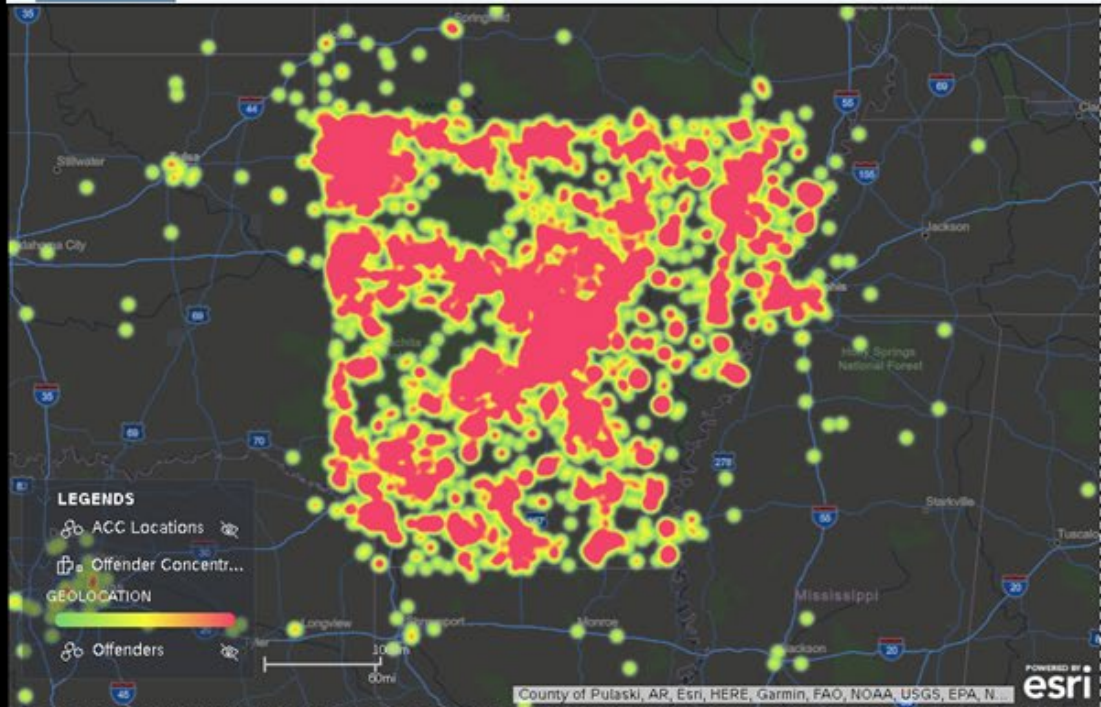

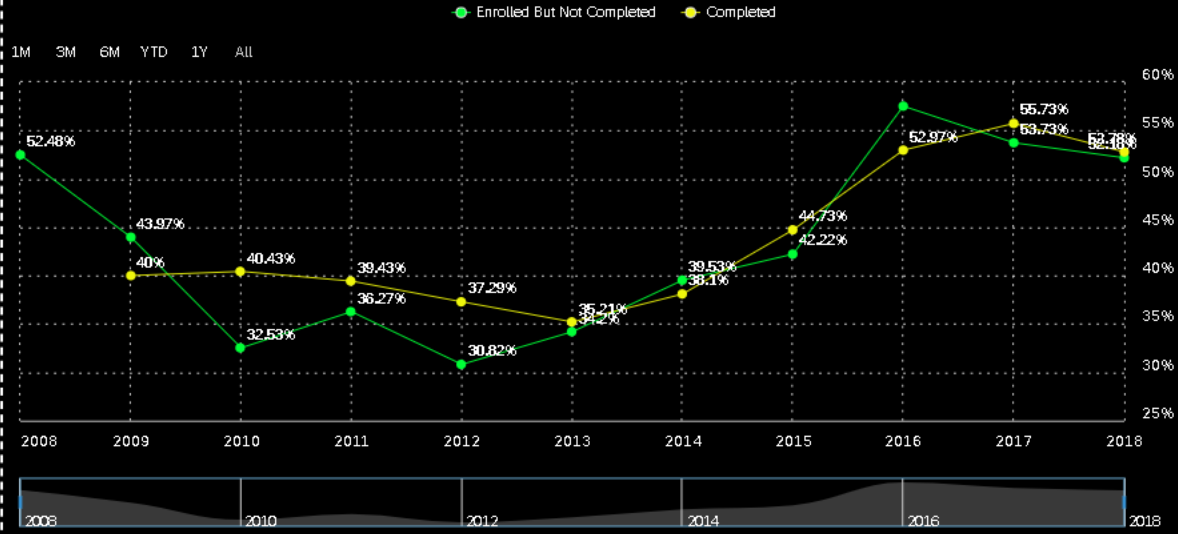


Average Distance(mi) BY Offender Count BY Office



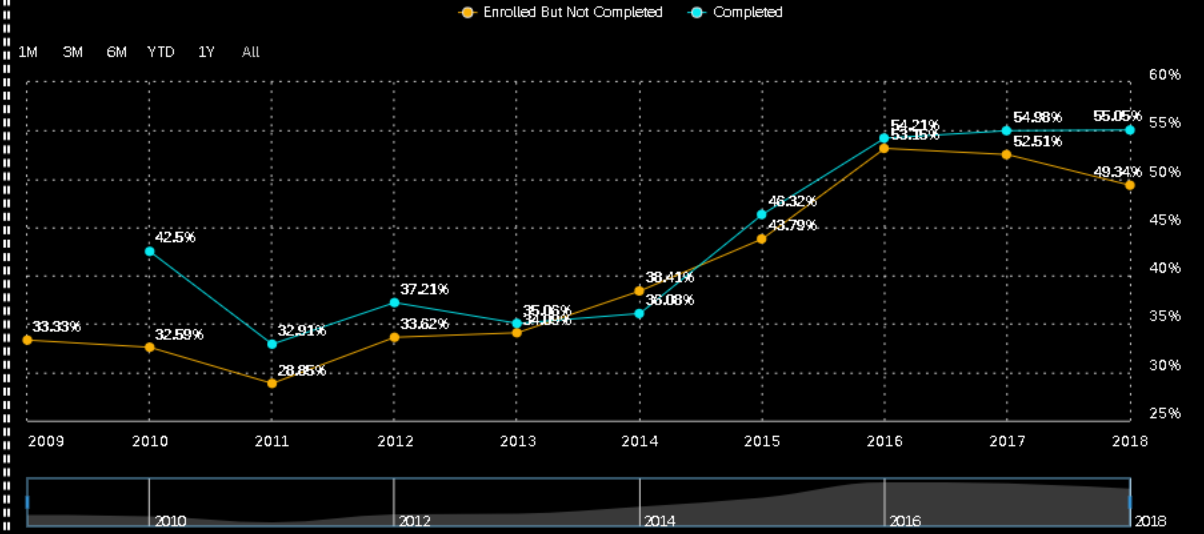
Recidivism Rate per Anger Management (P), Date Hierarchy

in % | 3 Filters applied



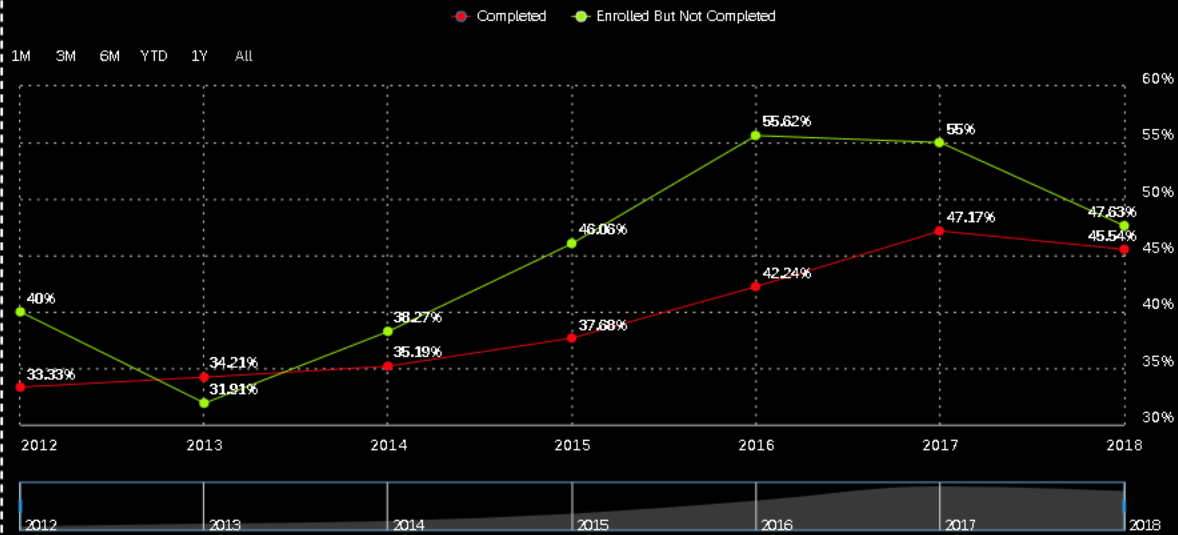
Recidivism Rate per Date Hierarchy, Thinking Errors (P)

in % | 3 Filters applied



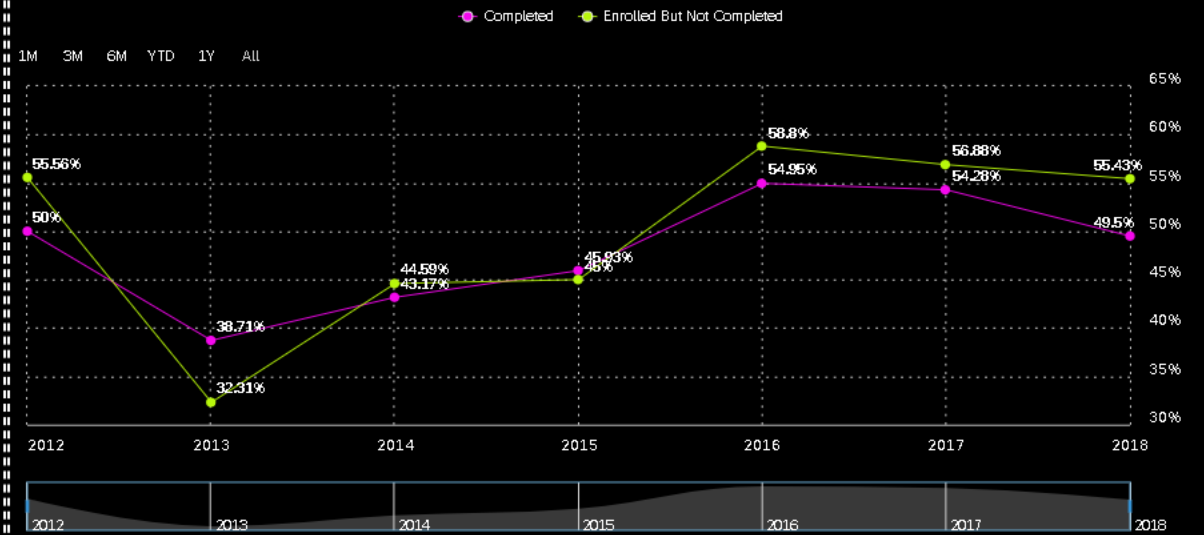
Recidivism Rate per Communication Skills (P), Date Hierarchy

in % | 3 Filters applied

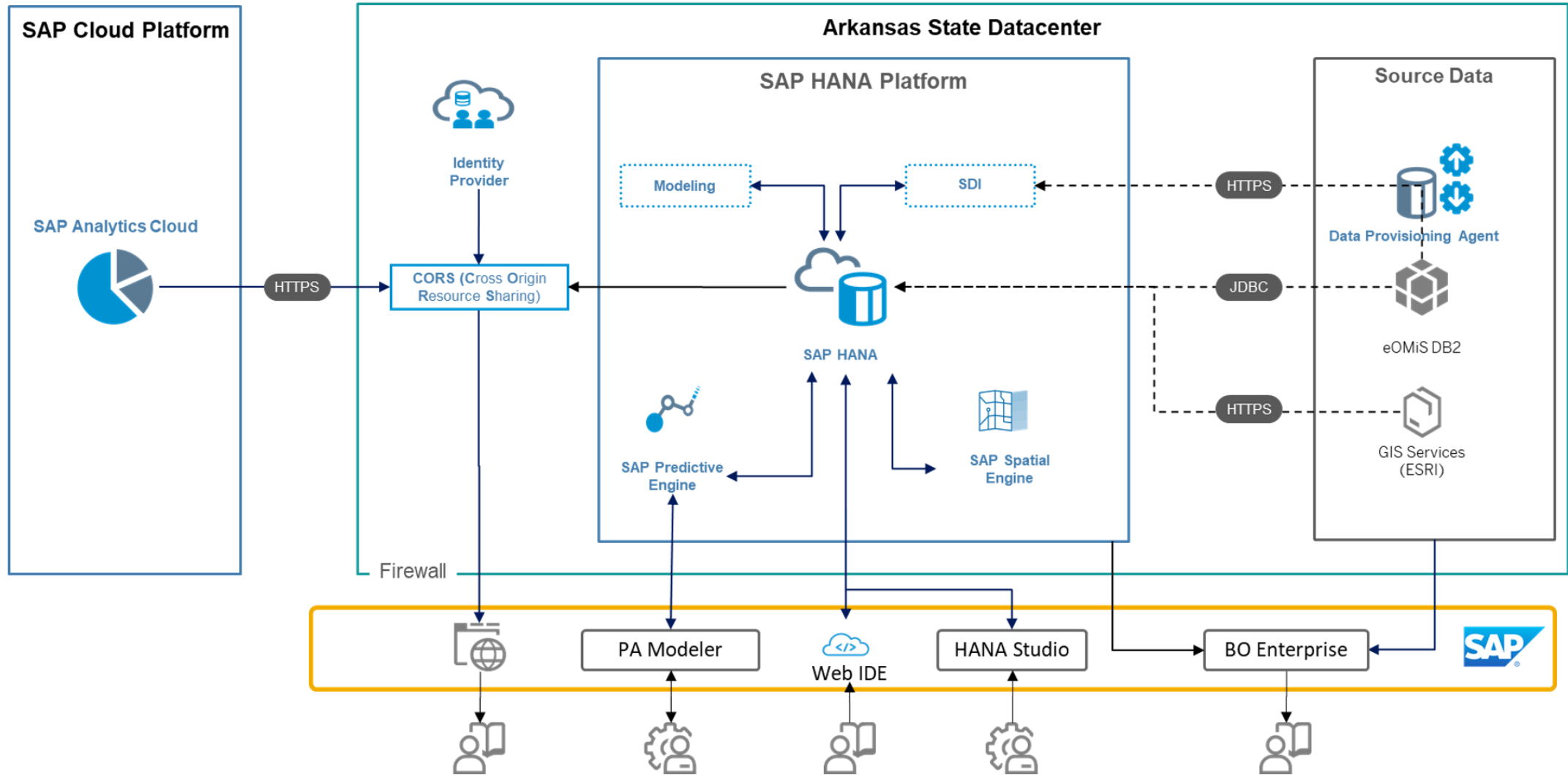


Recidivism Rate per Date Hierarchy, Domestic Violence (P)
