Challenge: Rising Prison Population




Cost of maintaining status quo in additional spending over next six years.

Key Stat: Arkansas' prison population grew 26% in the past decade vs a decline of 4.5% nationally



Timeline



The data sharing agreement that enabled the POC took approximately 8 months compared to the 3 months of technical work. Data sharing is a critical component to utilizing technology to tackle complex issues.






#Statewide Supervision Population Trend




County Jail Backup by Geo-location







Intervention Risk Trajectory




