Background

In New York Power Authority many of the forms were implemented long time ago nearing the first implementation back in 1998. Mainly SAP Script was used initially and then NYPA transition over to SmartForms with time. NYPA also used third party tools like StreamServe for Bill Prints.

However, with ever increasing business needs fast turn around time was required, and better formatted forms needed. NYPA is transitioning to PDF based forms.

Transition to PDF Forms (from SmartForms)

- Multiple Page Layout support and graphical editor is easy-to-use and has many more functionalities
- Reads data from SAP and displays it in PDF format as opposed to GUI display
- Interactive Forms to save data in SAP
- Form retains its appearance regardless of the environment
- Adobe document security options are possible like Digital signature validation, Disable save, select or Print option

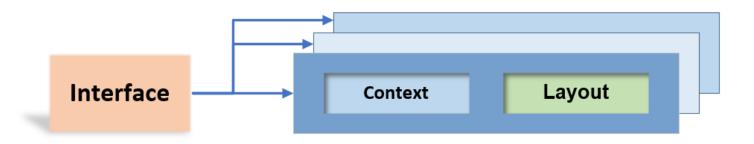


SAP Adobe Forms – Overview

SAP Interactive Forms by Adobe is the latest form technology which is rendered by SAP and Adobe to create and edit PDF forms for printing in SAP systems.

An activated PDF-based form corresponds to a callable function module in the SAP system. The application program uses the function module interface to send the data. Therefore, the data collection process is split from the logic of the form. This means that you only need to adjust the form when you modify the logic or layout.

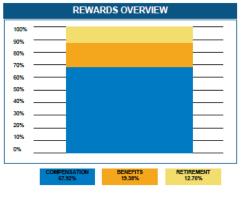

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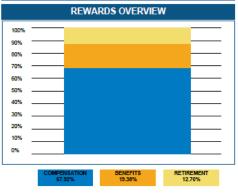

Challenges (and solutions)

- Complex page formats with Page Breaks and Headers
 - ✓ Created two separate Forms for first 3 pages and other for all remaining pages till end of Bill.
 - ✓ Conditional Page Breaks for each contract and making it exactly like previous Layout
- Number of Page limitation maximum 2000 Pages
 Only in conventional Adobe Form
 - ✓ Process one contract at a time in loop and create separate page for each contract
 - ✓ Join all pages in one file in the end

 - ✓ Debugging Form %work
- SOAP Runtime Exception Error
 - ✓ ABAP & JAVA Stack communication error
- Complex Calculations and E-Files generation
 - ✓ Handled in User Exit
