# A 67-Year-Old Start-Up

The well-being of animals – from cats to cows – has never been more important to society. But it's been important to us since our start in 1954.

#### 1954

New plant and animal science activities are organized and combined into Lilly's Agricultural and Industrial Sales Division

#### 1970

Elanco expands international operations to 38 global affiliates and 17 manufacturing plants

#### 1990s

Elanco Products Company is renamed Elanco Animal Health, focusing solely on animal health products

#### 2014

Elanco acquires Lohmann Animal Health and Novartis Animal Health

#### 2019

Elanco completes full divestiture from Lilly

#### 2021

Elanco acquires Kindred Biosciences, expanding pet health pipeline in dermatology and other chronic disorders

#### 1960

The Agricultural and Industrial Sales Division is reorganized, and Elanco Products Company is launched

#### 1980s

R&D begins to shift away from plant science and towards animal health

#### 2000s

Elanco acquires livestock vaccine companies, launches Its companion animal business and Elanco Knowledge Solutions

#### 2018

Elanco (NYSE: ELAN) becomes a publicly traded animal health company

#### 2020

Elanco completes acquisition of Bayer Animal Health





#### Geography




#### **Revenue Category**

Enhanced cattle portfolio; Poultry remains significant






# Elanco SAP Project in few words:

#### What is E-Invoicing

- E-Invoicing is a common name for Electronic Invoicing.
- E-Invoicing is a form of Electronic billing. It is a legal and fiscal substitute for the paper bill.
- E-invoicing is used by trading partners, such as customers and their suppliers, to present and monitor transactional documents between one another and ensure the terms of their trading agreements are being met.
- E-invoicing includes number of different technologies and entry options and is used as an umbrella term to describe any method by which an invoice is electronically presented to a customer for payment.
- Not all documents sent in electronic forms are E-Invoices. It needs to meet certain requirements,
   specifications and guidelines stipulated in the country of issue.

## Introduction to Global E-Invoicing Regulations

- Most governments around the world are promoting electronic invoicing (e-invoicing)
  models to support invoice and payment processing between companies (B2B models)
  and between service providers and governments (B2G models). E-invoicing helps:
  - Governments exert fiscal control over transactions taking place within their countries
  - Governments and companies modernize invoice and payment approval interactions
  - Companies increase the efficiency and security of invoice and payment processes
- Governments are using e-invoicing to implement fiscal controls and maximize tax revenues

## Introduction to Global E-Invoicing Regulations (Cont'd)

Many governments mandate that vendors electronically submit invoices to tax authorities for registration and validation before sending them to customers, and electronically submit payment notifications to tax authorities for approval once received. Some governments also mandate that vendors use authorized providers to issue these documents. To comply, vendors must meet several country-specific legal and technical requirements

# E-Invoicing Regulations benefits – Example country - India

- There are several important benefits associated with India's move to e-invoicing
- Among other benefits, the move to e-Invoicing will help:
  - Promote "Digital India"
  - Reduce tax evasion
  - Reduce paper consumption
  - Increase invoice accuracy
  - Increase invoice processing times
  - Reduce the number of invoice-related disputes
  - Allow for real time transaction data access by tax authorities
  - Eliminate the need for many reconciliations
  - Eliminate non-standardized invoice formats
  - Increase interoperability among businesses





Elanco S/4 HANA **ERP System** 









#### **SAP's Document Compliance Solution**

- Elanco will use an SAP solution to process e-invoices in some countries.
- SAP's Document Compliance Solution allows companies to transform documents
  created in other SAP applications into eDocuments in predefined exchange formats and
  electronically transfer them to external systems (e.g., of tax authorities)
- The solution can transform multiple types of SAP documents into eDocuments:




 The solution can also transmit eDocuments to external systems and update eDocuments with information received from external systems



SAP eDocuments refer to e-invoices which applies to invoices, credit notes (including rebates), debit notes, returns, and FI direct posting documents

#### SAP's Document Compliance eDocument Cockpit

- The eDocument Cockpit is the primary tool within the Document Compliance solution and offers a unified user experience for monitoring and managing the eDocuments
- The Cockpit can be used to submit eDocuments to tax authorities, monitor eDocument statuses, send eDocuments via e-mail, and more as described in the next module
