1. **OpenText Software GmbH** of Werner-von-Siemens-Ring 20 85630, Grasbrunn, Bayern Germany ("OT")
2. **Smith Consulting GmbH** of Eibelstrasse 2, CH-8500 Frauenfeld, Switzerland ("Consultant")

Recitals

- A. OT requires the provision of certain services, deliverables and/or products.
- B. The Consultant has represented that it has the necessary expertise and resources to provide the services, deliverables and/or products.
- C. The Consultant agrees to provide and OT agrees to acquire the services, deliverables and/or products on the terms of this Consulting Services Agreement (the "Agreement") and any relevant Statement of Work.

It is agreed as follows.

1. **PROVISION OF SERVICES.**

1.1 General. OT desires to retain Consultant as an independent contractor to perform demo system and presales support related services and prepare deliverables for OT, and Consultant is willing to perform such services on the terms and conditions set forth herein. **1.2 Services.** Consultant agrees to perform for OT demo system and presales support and related services and deliverables (collectively, the "Services") described in one or more Statements of Work attached hereto or as mutually agreed between the parties from time to time (each, a "SOW"). Each SOW shall contain contact information, the term, milestones, billing rates, a fee estimate, reporting requirements and any other terms relevant to the Services being performed thereunder. All SOWs shall be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. OT and Consultant acknowledge and agree that Consultant has the ability to set or negotiate Consultant's own rates for the Services performed. Consultant shall customarily and regularly exercise discretion and independent judgment in the performance of the Services.

1.3 Personnel. Consultant shall provide qualified personnel who meet the requirements, including, without limitation, education and training, experience and expertise, to satisfy the provision of Services required under each SOW. OT reserves the right to: (a) request resumes of Consultant's proposed personnel; and (b) whether prior to or during the performance of the Services, accept or reject such proposed personnel that OT determines in good faith are not qualified to perform the Services.

1.4 Independent Contractor. Consultant shall perform the Services hereunder as an independent contractor. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to constitute Consultant or its employees as an agent, employee or representative of OT. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to create or imply a relationship of either (a) joint venture, or (b) principal and agent relationship between the parties, and neither party shall have any right, power or authority to create any obligation, express or implied, on behalf of the other in connection with the performance of Services. Consultant agrees to furnish all tools and materials, and to incur all associated expenses necessary to perform the Services and other obligations under this Agreement, including, without limitation, providing all computer services and equipment and incurring all expenses related to telephone and secretarial services, except if such expenses are reimbursable as expressly provided in the applicable SOW. None of Consultant's employees will be eligible for any OT employee benefits. Consultant shall have sole responsibility for remitting taxes and providing benefits to its employees. Consultant and OT acknowledge and agree that outside of project completion dates and reasonable business hours (including the reasonable business hours of OT's customers to the extent applicable), the Consultant has the ability to set Consultant's own hours. Consultant further represents to OT that Consultant is customarily engaged in the same type of work performed under this Agreement with other entities and/or that Consultant holds itself out

with the services, including travel, meals, and other downtime. The consultant will also be required to provide insurance coverage in the amounts specified in the agreement. In addition, the consultant will be required to indemnify and hold OpenText harmless from any claims, losses, or damages arising out of or resulting from the work product or services. The agreement also includes confidentiality provisions.

Final invoices must be submitted within 10 days of the completion or termination of the agreement or SOW. OT will not be obligated to pay for any remaining fees and expenses if the final invoice is not received within this time period.

What are the Audit requirements?

The audit requirements are that the system must provide a log of all security-related events, including the identity of the user, the time and date of the event, the resource that was accessed, and the type of access (read, write, delete). The system must also provide a mechanism to trace all changes made to the security configuration of the system.

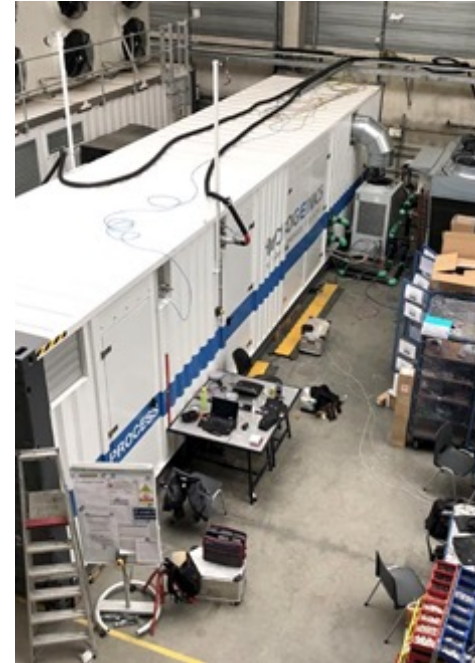
